



It always seems like your problems come at you at the worst of times, when you are either unable to handle it financially, mentally, physically, etc. Then, regardless of the difficulty you are experiencing, when things start to fall apart, they really start to fall apart. Maybe you experience a flat tire. Bully! This is never fun. How old is your spare? Will it even get me to a tire store? Does my insurance have roadside? I'm on my way to a meeting wearing a suit and tie, and this is going to happen now!!! Wait, there's no jack in the truck!! Okay, found the jack, but no handle to lower the tire. Wow, that last part seemed a little specific huh? By the way, we found the handle for the spare three days later under the hood of the truck. Just a little addition to that story, the roadside truck was dispatched to Aurora Colorado, I was just south of Berthoud. After sitting there for over two hours, the gentleman who owned the home, saw I was sitting there. (I thought I had already met him.) He walked up to me and offered me the proper jack, the floor jack on the dirt was useless. My dad had by this time got to me with a tire that would work, (because we did not have a handle.) I now was just short of three hours late for my meeting, and I had a second meeting in an hour and a half. Now equip with proper jack, tire, and I was in my T-shirt, no more tie. And in a matter of five minutes, I had a truck that was once again road worthy. Oh, look, roadside is here!! By this time, I was tired, frustrated, late, dirty, so thirsty, and I had a headache. One little issue ballooned into an afternoon alternating event.

Of course, I was in this situation because I did not have insurance on my car, and I could not drive it, again. My pops and mom have supported me above and beyond even their ability at times. Dad has given up his truck to me for weeks or months since my accident. If I need something moved, he is there. Dad could not know that the tire was bad because the year that my son was home from Japan, he had the truck. Point is, I was in the truck because of a financial hardship. This is the same hardship that had me behind on rent, and defaulted payment arrangements with utility companies. I know that in the world of disability, hell, all insurance situations, it is very hard to go from the lifestyle you once had to a very restricted lifestyle. Throw in other financial difficulties, increasing cost of living, and getting caught up seems difficult, a very steep uphill battle. Oh yeah, and as soon as you have a plan to pay something off, clear it out of your life worries, the hot water heater breaks down.

Then of course you have the situation where say you are a week away from getting a bonus, tax refund, paycheck, or lottery winnings, okay, maybe not the last one, and you get a call from the collection agency wanting exactly the amount you had earmarked for groceries. And then there's this, your vehicle, I'm sensing a theme, starts blowing black smoke and leaking fluid onto the ground. You have no warranty, and you are still paying the car off, I just pulled a little hair out, (I only have a little hair left,) and I'm not currently going through this situation. Every time, every time!!!

I laugh as I think of this, I have never had a difficult situation, a problem, pop up and said to myself, “thank goodness this happened now,” with glee and outright happiness. Now there are most defiantly times where a problem is easier to handle. I would much rather have it happen when I have a little money, time, or be in okay health to handle the situation. But it is still a problem.

Why does this always happen at these times? Simple. What other times are there? Problems would not be problems if they are easy to handle. Life would be so much easier to handle if you could schedule issues. Well, in a way, you can. I am going to preface this as this is a definite do as I say, not as a do story. You can prevent some auto fatalities by maintaining the vehicle, and not buying a Pontiac Montana, just bit through my tongue!! This will in no way prevent your car from breaking down. Those things don’t care, they like to watch you suffer. My suggestion is, buy something pre 80’s. They look cooler and you can work on them. Now, since that is a ridiculous statement, I would just suggest making sure you do everything you can prevent and to prepare yourself for upcoming failures. And the first thing you need to do is fix your mindset. Make the realization that there is never a good time for a problem. It does not exist.

I had a talk with a financial professional who I network with. He listened to the way I was speaking and asked me if he could give me some advice. I would like to pass some of this along and hopefully, it will strike a chord with you. Maybe it will help you, maybe it won’t. But these are all easy goals to strive for and I would like to invite you to join me as I make the dedication to dig myself out of a hole.

Living paycheck to paycheck, or as I call it, overdraw to overdraw, is a difficult way of life. “At times, however, it is the only way to live.” But with a little dedication, planning, and a lot of discipline, this is a mindset that can be overcome. We fall into traps where things become normal, even bad things, and we are comfortable with them. Once again, as I say, not do. Is it worth using an off brand instead of the overpriced name brand to make your financial life better? My family, can we only eat out 25 times a month? Well, we are going to start eating out a lot less. Sorry Ronald.

I quit smoking 15 years ago. When I quit, I was smoking three packs a day, Camel Wides, three cartons a week. I was curious and priced them the other day and was shocked to think that I would be spending over \$200 a week now. Instead of being smart and using the money I was saving by not keeping the camel fat, I found other vices. I found that, “hey, I can buy this now.” Did I need it? Probably not, hell, I probably don’t own most of it anymore. If I would have taken and put aside the price of one carton into a emergency fund, I would have, I just redid the math and I may pass out, If I would have put aside the price of one carton a week for the last 15 years, I would have had \$50,700 in an emergency fund. We all have a vice that we have given up. Think back, try to remember how much you used to spend. One example would be, every Thursday at the Smiling Moose we would host, “all you can eat” crab. It cost \$17. Now I never got to partake because I was cooking at that time. That \$17 that someone could commit to saving, and it would equal \$13,260. I know that people are no longer going to the all you can eat nights, because the Moose has been gone for quite a while. If you would put away the cost of a case of domestic beer every week, in 10 years, \$10,400 would be the result. Don’t give up the beer but make the decision to match it. \$20 in an emergency account.

Once again, at this time, we live overdraw to overdraw. I vow to withdraw \$60 less every month. I will also open a savings account that I will match that \$60 every month. This is going to be a way that eventually, slowly, I someday will have an account that when these problems pop up, and I say, “why does this happen now!!” I will have the means to not let it hurt me as much. Hell, in the next 15 years I will have the money to go and take the European castle tour I have always dreamed of. Maybe even hit up Egypt. I am not suggesting that you must quit anything, I don’t have that right. What I am suggesting is you think about one vice that you can match, one vice you can put a limit on, or even eliminate and use the excess to relieve the stress on your account. Join me in making a commitment to actively improving my situation. Join me in improving our overall health because, while yeah, things may be tight for a little while, imagine how much money you will save on overdraft fees alone. Imagine being able to dedicate your entire check to the prevention of problems. Dedicate yourself to a minor life change and open yourself to a life.

## When Someone You Love is in a Motorcycle Accident

Motorcycle riders are a tight-knit group. When I attend rallies, rides and other motorcycle events, I'm always inspired by the sense of camaraderie shared by bikers, who seem to walk around like they share the best secret in the world. They all love biking, bikers and bikes. They share a special bond.

That's why it can be deeply traumatic for so many people when a biker goes down. The ripples of pain spread through the community in larger and larger concentric circles, and everyone wants to help, which is another inspiring aspect of the biker community.

But a motorcycle accident is typically hardest on those closest to the injured biker. Spouses, children and parents suffer the most emotionally. Sadly, they may also suffer financially. There are very few "minor" motorcycle accidents. Injuries suffered by the rider and damages to their bike can require thousands and thousands of dollars to fix.

When I receive calls from people who need help from a Denver personal injury attorney after a motorcycle accident, I typically hear from spouses or significant others. Specifically, the biggest percentage of my calls come from wives and girlfriends. (There are more male bikers, hence more men are in accidents.) These women are usually completely overwhelmed by the things they're trying to manage on behalf of their loved ones, from medical treatments, health insurance questions, motorcycle insurance calls and their spouse's lost wages. On top of that, they are consumed by fear. Will my husband live? What will he be like when he leaves the hospital? Will life ever be normal again?

Often, I meet with spouses in their homes or in the hospital because the injured biker is bed-bound and wants to be part of the conversations we have on his behalf. In the most tragic cases, the biker has died and the spouse is completely adrift.



If you're reading this article and any of the above issues and emotions feel familiar, you have my empathy. I'm sorry you're facing such a terrifying and exhausting experience. Hopefully the next few suggestions will help to ease your burden or, at the very least, guide you to resources that can help.

Call [BikerDown.org](http://BikerDown.org): BikerDown is a non-profit organization that was established in 2011 with a mission to assist motorcycle accident victims. BikerDown provides emotional support to family members of injured or killed riders, medical equipment and even financial advice to help victims keep creditors at bay as they recover. To initiate the process, you need to complete a [help request](#) that indicates what kind of help you need. Someone from BikerDown will then respond within 24 to 48 hours and will schedule a personal visit with you.

Make sure you give your loved one's health insurance to the hospital; not his motorcycle insurance: Believe it or not, hospitals will do everything in their power (sometimes skirting the law) to charge victims the absolute maximum that they can. Even when the victim has health insurance, which should help to keep costs low, the hospital will ignore the health insurance and try to stake a claim on the injured motorcyclist's future legal settlement. It's healthcare billing fraud, and we're fed up with seeing it happen. Make sure you specifically tell the hospital that they only have your

permission to bill your loved one's health insurance and they *must* use his health insurance. In fact, I would put your expectations in writing. Check out [this article](#) for help with the language.

**Do not talk to the other driver's insurance company:** You need to think of the other driver's insurance company as an adversary. They are looking to protect their interests and, therefore, they will be looking for ways to get out of their responsibility to cover your costs. Don't give them the opportunity to do this! First of all, do not ever allow them to take a recorded statement. If they pressure you to make a recorded statement, make sure you have a personal injury attorney with you at the time. Additionally, by Colorado law, insurance companies are not allowed to use any statement that you make within 15 days of being in care or treatment after an accident. If they try to contact you and take your statement within this timeframe, seek an attorney immediately.

**Only tell your insurance company the bare minimum:** Sadly, even your own insurance company will do all they can to limit the amount that they must pay you. You are legally required to call them after you've been in an accident, but you can limit what you say. Here's my advice: give them as little information as possible in your initial call with them. Then, if you were injured in the accident, call a personal injury attorney for advice.

**Call a personal injury attorney:** If your loved one was injured in a motorcycle accident, you should call a personal injury attorney as soon as possible. I know this sounds self-serving, but the insurance companies truly do not care how badly your loved one was hurt. They have teams of attorneys and "service reps" on staff who are trained to find ways to limit their liability.

### Take Preventative Measures

Now, if you've read this entire article and you're lucky enough to never have lost a loved one to a motorcycle accident, I'm happy for you! But I hope you will also encourage your biker to purchase enough insurance to make sure you won't be destitute after taking care of his medical needs. 



Colorado Cares Outreach and Entertainment is built on being an immediate assistance program to help families and individuals with items that are needed for a happy, healthy, life. These are items that day to day life would be very difficult without. Clothing, housewares, food, clean water, service assistance links and more. This is a service that is open to everyone. There is no bias, no judgement, and very few questions. We need to know what you need, how can we continue to help, and a little history of your situation. Everyone runs into problematic situations. Hurt at work or otherwise, underpaying jobs, laid off, home tragedy, (home fire, flood) new to town and need a lift to get started. This program is also for the family if someone in the family makes a mistake, inadvertently putting the family into a situation. Two key situations would be, a home catches fire. This will leave a family with their head spinning. We offer clothing, housewares and toiletries to the family along with, if available, a donated meal for the family to sit together and realize that they did not lose everything. Or say a family leader has a little too much to drink and gets stopped. This should not mean the family has to go hungry or be without school supplies or clothing. We are there to help the family continue as uninterrupted lifestyle as possible. This way, they can concentrate on being there for the health and support of their family leader. This is a non-monetary program. We can help families raise money through the CommunityPIF (Pay It Forward) Fundraising Program, [www.CommunityPIF.com](http://www.CommunityPIF.com). Our mission is to be there to lessen the burden of traumatic situations. Remembering that all is not lost is so very important. We know this first hand. I made myself so miserable after my incident thinking about everything that we lost. And yes, we lost a lot! But I still had my family, my friends, my boys, and a big smelly dog that loves me. And lucky them, they still had me..... We know the challenges, we want to help.

One of the worst things as a parent is when a situation comes up, it never comes up at a good time. Why, why does your car break down right before taxes? How the hell does it know?? The hot water heater loves to make sure that the work bonus you worked hard for is not enjoyed, While we can give you suggestions on places to go to get those items fixed, (and to donate at the same time) we will be able to offer replacements for items lost in emergency situations.

We offer donated clothing for those in the community that are displaced. No one needs to become ill because they do not have suitable clothing. Kids should never have to walk to school without a coat, or poor shoes. A person should never have to chose between feeding the family or buying the work clothing that they need to start a new job, not when we can prevent this situation. Business is Our Middle Name

I would like to ask if you have a moment so I can to explain Colorado Cares Outreach & Entertainment. I will do my best to keep this brief, but this is me. Brief is not a strong suit for me.

I would like to tell you about plans for the Colorado Cares Relief Center. We have a connection with a great group in Denver that started a mission for the displaced down south called Impact. Please anytime you are down in their area, donate to help them out, they do GREAT work. They started a store front for those in need to walk in, grab what they need without the unnecessary hassle of other organizations. Troy started this last year, but Impact has been around for a while. We have had conversations in the past and being as likeminded as we are, we have tried to support each other as much as possible. We would like to take a cue from Troy, and Impact, and expand it a little for our Northern Colorado neighbors in need. As I write this, it is -8 degrees. There are people suffering everyday with these very cold temperatures. Once again, we are not vowing that we have the answers to all problems, but as a community, we can help. Clayton Consulting & Event Planning llc. Has a mission to obtain enough land in the Northern Colorado Area for two, already donated double wide mobile units. With plans to also add two additional large buildings for employment training, and the store front, bicycle, tent, and air mattress repair, and even a volunteer lunch area. The other building will be used as a cold shelter, with partnerships we are building to get individuals a ride. This will be a sober stay safe home for both women, and men. With this addition, and all the hard work of other facilities in the Northern Colorado, there will be enough space available for individuals who will not fit in overwhelmed facilities. The death rate in North Colorado has been raising every year, this does not have to be the case. If we work together, we can make a difference, give people hope, give people a chance.

Colorado Cares Outreach and Entertainment has the mission to help all that is need of assistance with donations from our neighbors. Giving people the alternate option to donate and know that the clothing, housewares, school supplies, toiletries, fuel and grocery gift cards will go to people who truly need the help. Colorado Cares is not now, nor will we ever be a thrift store. We will be exploring our options on how best to make sure your donations, that are necessary to daily, healthy living, are available to people in the community that truly need the items. There will not be a price tag on clothing, unless it comes to us with a price tag on it. When we created Colorado Cares, we took into account of the angst people have with donating. People donate for community support, and then it gets used for corporate gains.

When you go into a local thrift shop where people donate to, if you are in desperate need of clothing, you have to pay for it. This to me has never made any sense. People donate clothing for this reason!! Once again, unlike these unnamed 501c3 thrift stores, we will not sell these items. Clothing is a necessity for good health. If you have worn out clothing, illness is much more likely. If you do not have the proper clothing, things could be even worse. This has always been seen as a winter issue, but it is not. Having the improper clothing for the damaging sun and harsh summer weather can also cause damage to a body. There really is no reason why anyone should ever have to go without clothing simply because someone wants to put a price tag on donations.

Colorado Cares O&E is soon to be 501c3 registered non-profit program that has the mission to be a in the minute assistance program. We want to be there for people who need assistance after disasters, injuries, accidents, mistakes, or simply for people who are down on their luck. This is not a financial assistance program. CommunityPIF is a route possible in those situations. We will be there after a home fire to assist getting clothing, toys toiletries, food and needed medical equipment when needed and available. We will then offer a meal certificate to a local, generous eatery so the family can sit down, catch a breath, and remember that they did not loose everything. They still have each other! It is important that we never take the last one for granted. The very first thing that pops in your head after you have been injured is generally all the things you no longer have control of. When you lose control of your financial independence, you instantly feel hopeless. There is nothing that I can say that is going to stop that feeling. There is nothing that can be said to ease that concern. You work very hard for the lifestyle you possess. When it starts to get taken from you piece by piece, it hurts, it hurts a lot. Then, insurance, no matter what kind we are talking about, health, accident, unemployment, life insurance works on their own time frame. While there is nothing that CCEP or anyone else can do to make them work faster, without treating you in an unfair manner. We say it often, but we must say it again, while yes, it does slow things down, do not sign anything the insurance company gives you. You sign what is best for them, not best for you. They will word it to where you will no longer have things imperative to you, like continuing health care. Then the great sum of money they send you, will be worse than the tragedy you suffered. Sad fact, this is not a maybe, this is the norm. Insurance CEO's are not making the multi millions by giving people more than they can get away with.

In many cases, we will investigate your specific case and see if we could offer more assistance to you through the Community Pay It Forward Fundraising Program. While this may not be able to offer you 100% of your lost wages, it could help you keep the home, car, electricity service, and it could most defiantly help you keep food on your table for you and your kids. While the Colorado Cares program is open to everyone, CommunityPIF does have rules and limitations of eligibility. See [www.CommunityPIF.com](http://www.CommunityPIF.com) for details.




